St. John the Baptist – Greeter/Usher/Lector/Choir Singer or Instrument

These opportunities happen several times throughout the year. You will be contacted for the needed training in Oct. For #1-3: New scheduling begins in Dec. #4 begins right away!

1. Lectors: Proclaim the readings from Scripture at Mass once a month.
2. Ushers: Greet and assist parishioners with seating, collection and communion procession for 4-5 weeks at one Mass, off for about 2 months.
3. Greeter: Greet parishioners at the doors before weekend Masses, arrive 20 minutes before Mass once a month. Families can do this together!
4. Choir member: be a member of a men's, mixed, or youth group choir (7th-12th grade) using your singing voice and/or playing an instrument once a month.

St. John the Baptist Catechist Aide for Grades 1-5

Monday or Wednesday evenings during the Faith Formation year (5:45-7:15pm) at St. John the Baptist School

Share your Catholic faith weekly with the youth of our parish by assisting an adult catechist with the lesson for each week throughout the program. You will receive a teacher's manual, and you can choose which grade to be a part of.

St. John the Baptist Churchtime

1/month on Sundays from September-May (9:45am-10am Mass) in church

Help the 4-year-olds through 1st grade youth understand the Gospel story at their level by helping them with a variety of activities and to stay on task. You would be assigned 1 Sunday a month to volunteer (with your input). **This does not replace your regular Saturday/Sunday Mass obligation.** You will need to attend another Mass outside of this volunteer experience.

Parish Babysitting

As needed with dates and parish location TBD. Available starting Sept. 5, 2017.

Sign up to be a babysitter for various times throughout the year. Help out 2 or more times depending on what your schedule allows. You would be notified through email.

St. Vincent de Paul **10-12 volunteers**

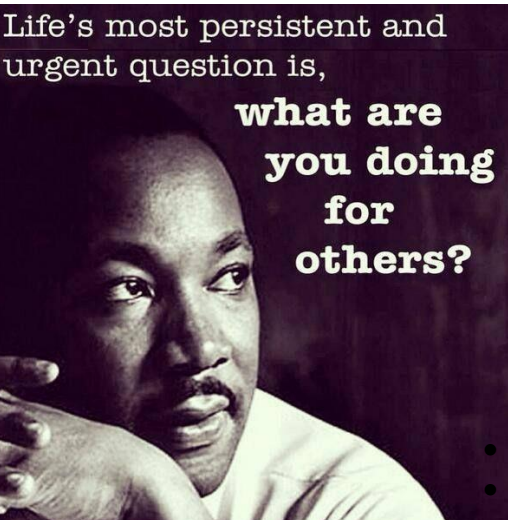
