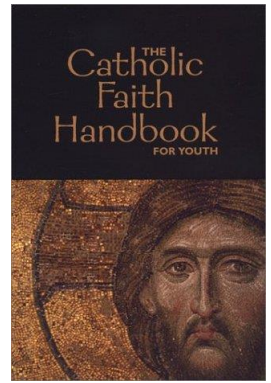


High School & Confirmation Program Overview

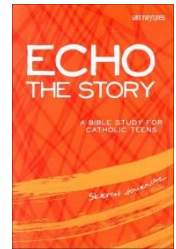

Freshman Year

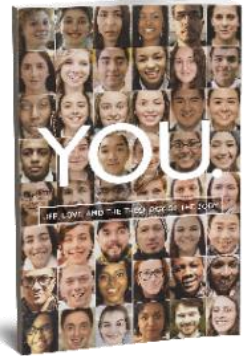
