Earlier this month, a group of about 40 people from St. John's went Christmas caroling together!






### MONTHLY HOLY HOUR






### FIRST SATURDAY DEVOTIONS



Stacks of pancakes, sausage, coffee & juice will be served all morning in the school gym.

Thanks to all of you who supported our FMSC fundraising and packing effort in 2024. Your support was overwhelming! Week in and week out, the end world hunger globe was filled with quarters and cash donations!

Together, our 10 partner churches funded and packed 520,812 meals this year with the help of over 3,000 volunteers. The meals we packed this year have already reached their destinations. Feed My Starving Children works with dedicated partners throughout the world to make sure 99% of all meals packed get to the people who need them the most. The following is a list of where our meals went and the FMSC partner (in parenthesis) that helped deliver the meals on the receiving end.

- 272,160 meals to the Dominican Republic—745 children fed for a year (Cross Catholic Outreach)
- 209,952 meals to Sierra Leone—575 children fed for a year (Life for Relief and Development)
- 38,700 meals to Cambodia—106 children fed for a year (Kinship United)






